

## 2020 Jax Cracker Pine Car Race Rules (Braves & Princesses)

### Car Block, Dimension, & Weight

- The pine wood block from the supplied pine car kit must be used. The block may be shaped in any way that is desired.
- The overall length of the car shall not exceed 7 inches.
- The overall width of the car shall not exceed 2  $\frac{3}{4}$  inches.
- The car must have 1  $\frac{3}{4}$ " clearance between the wheels.
- The car must have at least 3/8" clearance underneath the body so it does not rub on the center guide rail.
- The car shall not exceed 5 ounces.

### Wheels and Axles

- Only the wheels from the supplied pine car kit will be allowed.
- The wheels may not be cut, drilled, beveled or rounded but you may remove the seams and imperfections from the wheels.
- The axles may be altered, polished, and lubricated with a non-liquid lubricant (i.e. graphite).
- Wheel bearings, washers, springs and bushings are prohibited.

### Misc

- Each car must pass inspection by the official inspection committee before it will be allowed to compete. The race officials have the responsibility to disqualify those cars that do not meet these rules.
- You cannot enter a car from a previous year!
- The official race scale that is used at car check-in shall be considered final.
- Once a car passes inspection and is entered into the race, only the race officials can touch it. Modifications will not be allowed after the car is entered.
- If a car loses a wheel, or is otherwise damaged during the race, the race participant will be allowed 5 minutes to make repairs provided that the car is not otherwise altered.
- Starting devices, finish line devices, propellants, or propulsion systems are prohibited.
- Cars with wet paint or sticky surfaces will not be permitted on the track.
- There will be awards given for fastest cars and best in show (boys and girls).
- The race officials have final judgement for anything not covered completely in these rules.

## 2020 Jax Cracker Pine Car DAD Race Rules

This will be the first running of the Jax Cracker Dad Race! After the regular Jax Cracker race is finished and the awards have been presented to the kids, we will have an epic race for the dads. The rules are a little more loose- heavier cars, altered wheels, etc. so have fun with it! This will be a free event, so order any pine car kit online and show up with your entry.

### Car Block, Dimension, & Weight

- Any pine car kit may be used.
- The overall length of the car shall not exceed 7 inches.
- The overall width of the car shall not exceed 2 ¾ inches.
- The car must have 1 ¾" clearance between the wheels.
- The car must have at least 3/8" clearance underneath the body so it does not rub on the center guide rail.
- The car shall not exceed 8 ounces.

### Wheels and Axles

- Any pine car wheels will be allowed!
- Alter the wheels however you want- go crazy!
- The axles may be altered, polished, and lubricated with a non-liquid lubricant (i.e. graphite).
- Wheel bearings, washers, springs and bushings are totally allowed!

### Misc

- Each car must pass inspection by the official inspection committee before it will be allowed to compete. The race officials have the responsibility to disqualify those cars that do not meet these rules.
- Only one car per dad... and please don't enter the same car that your kid raced!
- The official race scale that is used at car check-in shall be considered final.
- Once a car passes inspection and is entered into the race, only the race officials can touch it. Car modifications will not be allowed after the car is entered.
- If a car loses a wheel, or is otherwise damaged during the race, the race participant will be allowed 5 minutes to make repairs provided that the car is not otherwise altered.
- Starting devices, finish line devices, propellants, or propulsion systems are prohibited.
- Cars with wet paint or sticky surfaces will not be permitted on the track.
